OUTPUT AT THE LEVEL OF BACK TO SCHOOL PROJECTS

The organization paid a visit to the children of Government School (G.S) Nwangong, Government School (G.S) Nzenteche, and Government Bilingual Secondary School (G.B.S.S) Emolah-Nwangong, Alou subdivision, Lebialem as well as catholic primary school Sasse in the community of Tole in the Southwest Region

As part of the organization's back to school project, financial assistance was given to students and pupils of the aforementioned schools, to aid the registration process for seventeen (18, 6M 12F) class six pupils who are to sit for the 2023/2024 end-of-course examination (First School Leaving Certificate and Common Entrance Examinations). A sum of two hundred and fifty-five thousand francs (255,000frs) was given for this purpose.

In addition to this, a sum of eighty thousand francs (80,000frs) was given to aid the registration of four (4, 2M 2F) students who are to sit in for the Ordinary Level (O/L) 2023/2024 General Certificate of Education (GCE) Examination.
